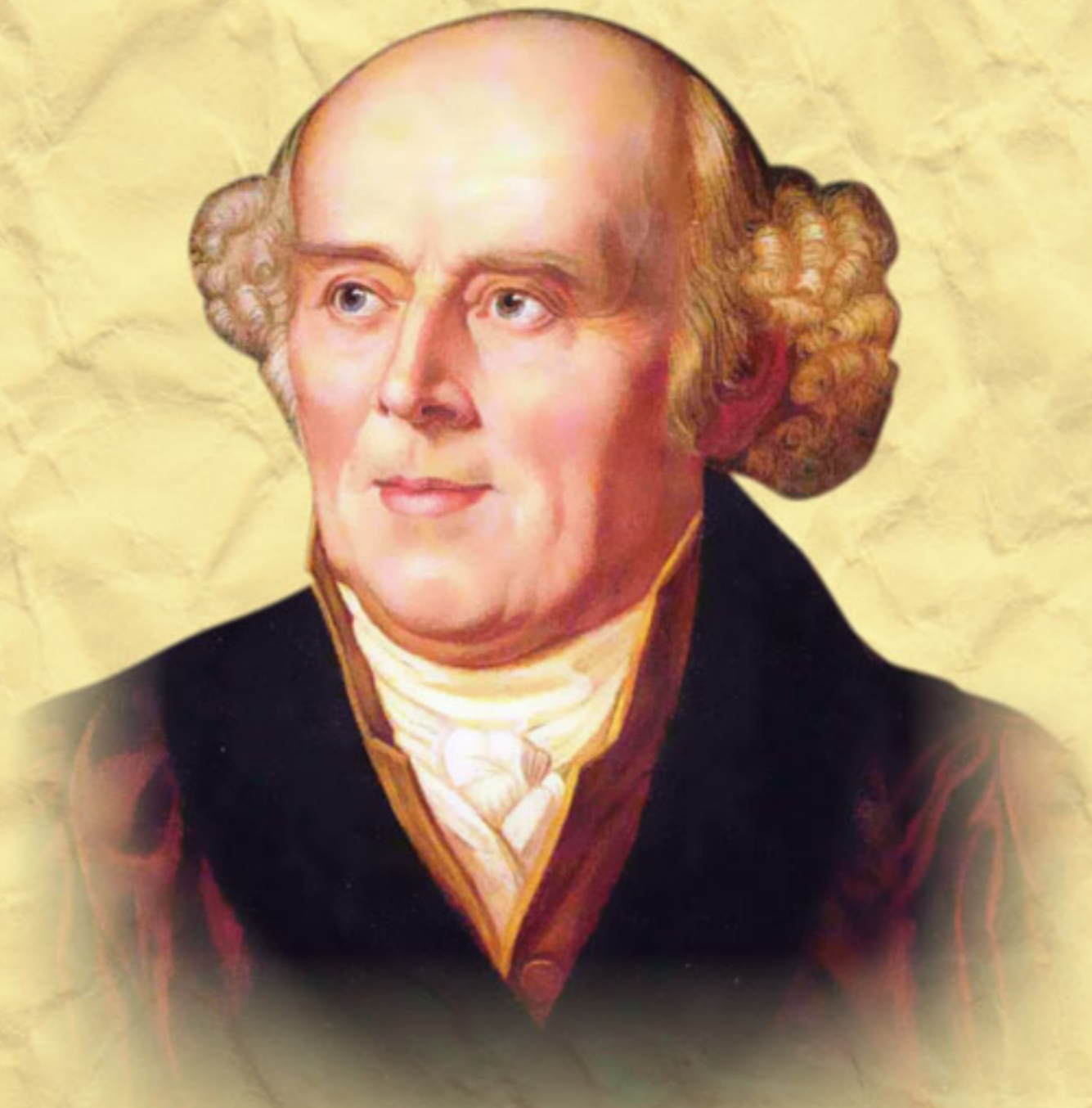

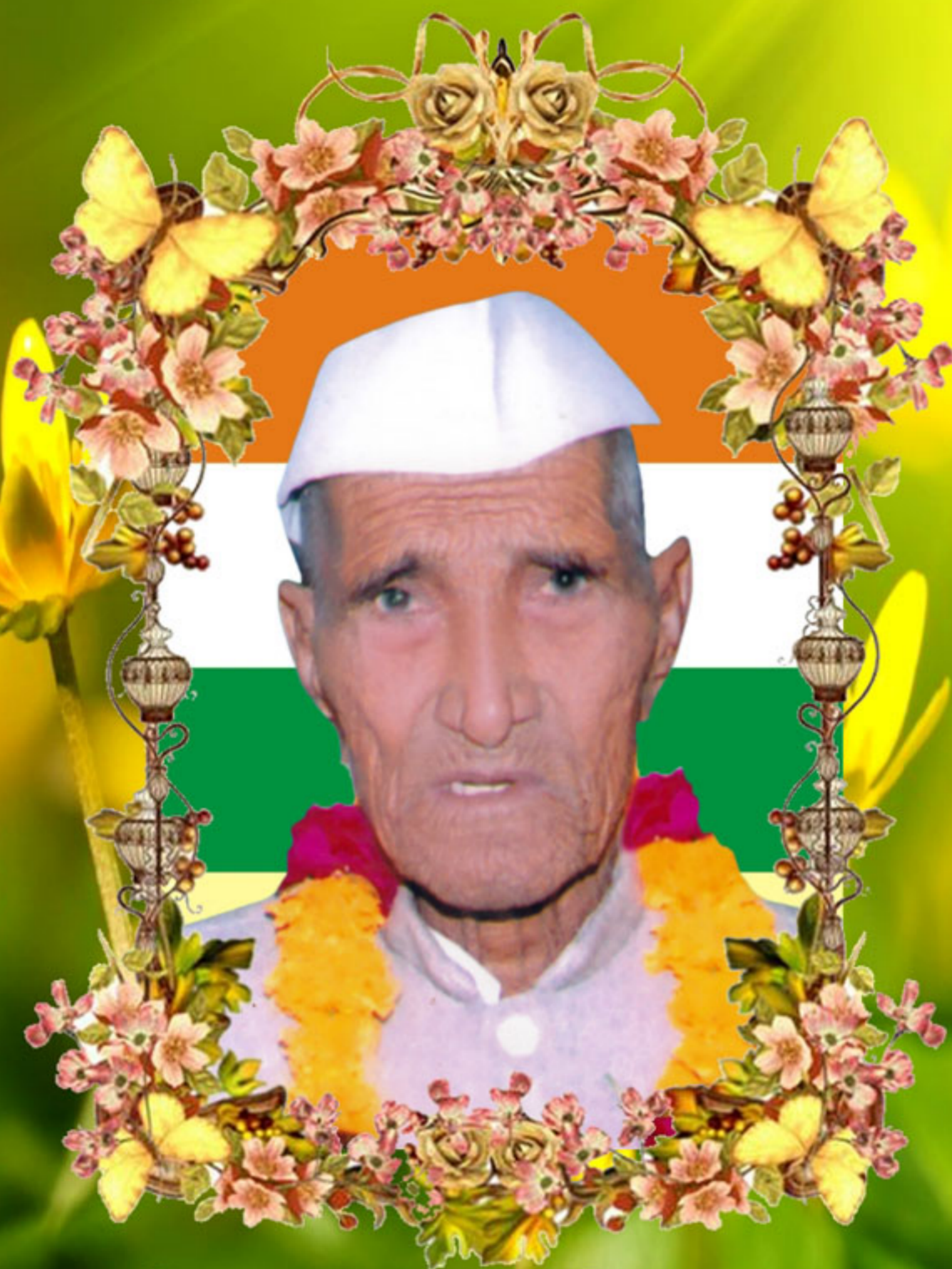

# What is Homoeopathy?

Homeopathy is an alternative health science that treats the patients with small amounts of the homoeopathic medicines. The unique feature of homoeopathic medicines is that these medicines in larger diseases can cause the same disease in healthy people, but in smaller amounts, these medicines cure the same disease in unhealthy people.

## Scope of BHMS

Advantages of homoeopathy are treating the patient directly as a whole not the disease by its name, it do drug proving on human beings not on animals, no side effects, no use of serum and injections, using freshly prepared plants and tinctures, goes to root of problem and gives right medicine, doses are minimum and thus restore health gently. Medicines do not act directly on microorganisms but acts on human system to fight against disease process. Therefore, no microbial resistance develops against drugs. Homoeopathic drugs are not addictive once relief occurs, the patient can easily stop it. The treatment is cost effective than other therapeutic systems.

## Career after BHMS

Homoeopathic education provides its service almost in all parts of country. Physicians are giving their service in public and private sector in both rural and urban areas.

In public sector jobs are conducted by union Public Service Commission (UPSC) and State Public service Commissions.

Registration with registers maintained by the state bodies (State Homoeopathic Board/Councils) and central body (CCH) permits practice of medicine through homoeopathic at all levels primary, secondary, and tertiary health care. Most of the practitioners give medicines from their own clinic which does not required any dispensing licenses. Homoeopathic software that is used by practitioners make homoeopathy easy to maintain record, assist in case taking, recommendations, and follow up.

## Government Jobs after BHMS

The basic health care service is provided to general public by homeopathic hospitals and dispensaries set by government. The homoeopathic dispensaries run by Central and State Governments and other bodies including Municipal Councils provide primary health care services.

# B.H.M.S.

Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine and Surgery

COURSE

## Duration :

5 ½ years including compulsory internship of one year duration after passing the final degree examination.

## Minimum Qualifications:

Intermediate Science (10+2) with Physics, Chemistry and Biology subjects or equivalent.

Minimum age limit is 17 years.

## Abbreviated Syllabus

Basic objectives of education and training in a Homoeopathic institution is to prepare a competent Homoeopathic Physician who is capable of functioning independently and effectively under Rural and Urban set ups

In order to achieve this, the following syllabus and curriculum has been designed:

In 1st BHMS, student shall study the fundamental principles of Homoeopathy and will also learn more of applied anatomy than a multitude of minor anatomical details.

In IInd BHMS, a student shall be exposed to very vital concepts of susceptibility and symptomatology with Analysis-Evaluation and details of the Homoeopathic concepts, old logic of Homoeopathy. These will attain much deeper significance (if care is taken by teachers of pathology and Organon-Philosophy) when the current knowledge of INFLAMMATION, IMMUNITY, is correlated well with concepts of susceptibility.

In IIIrd BHMS, there is opportunity to fortify the foundation at the best by correlating between Theory of Chronic Diseases and the Patho-Physiological facts on the Gynecology, Surgery and Medicine. A student shall have to be taught the spectrums of various diseases in correlation with the spectrum of miasmatic manifestations. He will then be able to use a well concluded EVALUATION ORDER OF Characteristics to derive an operationally valid repertorial Totality.

The knowledge gathered in this pattern will keep him constantly aware of his objectives and his role as a Homoeopathic Physician. The Integration will eliminate the state of confusion. The Therapeutics Actions then will be right and complete, utilizing the full repertories of the Medicinal and Non-medicinal measures, keeping him up-to-date about all fresh scientific developments and inculcating values of Continuous Medical Education.

## Examinations

- Each theory paper shall be of three hours duration.
- The Practical/oral examination shall be completed immediately after the theory Examination.
- There shall be two examinations in a year. One Regular examination and another Supplementary, The supplementary examination may be conducted within 6 months of the Regular examination
- No student shall be permitted to join para-clinical/clinical group of subjects until he has passed in all the pre clinical subjects of First BHMS for which he will be permitted not more than four chances including the original examination.
- **Attendance:** 75% attendance in a subject for appearing in the examination is compulsory. The examining body may relax this on exceptional circumstances on individual merit.



# Rules & Regulations

**NO RAGGING**

1. Every student admitted to the B.H.M.S. course shall have to follow rules and regulations of the College.
2. Every student will have to attend classes and practical work regularly as per the CCH requirements.
3. In case of illness, permission shall have to be obtained from the principal to remain absent from studies.
4. Rules and regulations of the hostel shall have to be followed and order of the warden will have to be adhered to.
5. Every student shall have to remain in the hostel. Staying outside the hostel will not be allowed. Parents or guardians of the students may appoint any body as local guardian if so desired. In case of appointment of local guardian, the entire personal data along with the photograph of local guardian will have to be submitted. On the request of local guardian, if a student is allowed to go out of the hostel, the responsibility will be of the parents who have appointed the local guardian.
6. The local guardian can see their ward on Sundays only. In case of emergency, permission shall have to be obtained from the warden.
7. The students will be allowed to go for shopping once in a month or on a holiday.
8. All students shall have to follow rules and regulations of the college and hostel. No student will be provided any extra facilities nor requests will be entertained for providing in rooms electric appliances, almirah, stool, chair etc. other than provided by the college.
9. Two days per week are reserved for creative works.
10. Original certificates will be returned at the time of leaving the college.
11. **ENROLLMENT :**  
At the time of admission to the said course, candidates will have to pay the prescribed fee to get herself / himself enrolled with the M.P. Medical Science University, Jabalpur (M.P.) and submit all required certificates as required by the university.
12. **DISCIPLINE :**  
All the students will have to abide strictly by the rules and regulations of the college and hostel during their studies enforced from time to time. Any violation will be strictly dealt with. The Principal reserves the right to rusticate students found indulging in acts prejudicial to the interest of the institute or involved in gross in discipline or immoral act.
13. **UNIFORM :**  
The candidate admitted for studies are bound to wear the uniform ordered by the institution. Presently the uniform includes White Kurta and White Salwar for the girls students and White shirt with white shirt for boys students with apron, white sockings and Black shoes. If necessary the uniform can be changed by the college management.
14. **JURISDICTION :**  
In case of any dispute decision of the Principal will be final and binding and if necessary in any case the territorial jurisdiction for suiting shall be limited to Gwalior only.
15. **SOCIAL SERVICE :**  
Once a week students will be involved in social work for two hours according to the instructions of the principal, Nursing College.
16. **BASIC COMPUTER PROGRAMMING :**  
Students will be provided knowledge and training in basic computer programming so as to enable them in handling the scientific data of research.
17. **Rs. 10000/- to be deposited as bus fair, which is compulsory in 1st Year.**
